

Reward Offered for Illegal Trapping

The Montana Trappers Association is a non profit organization incorporated in Montana in 1976 and is dedicated to the conservation and management of Montana's furbearing animals and the application of proper predator control methods. The MTA represents the organized trappers of Montana and through trapper and public education, maintains that trapping is a legitimate, desirable, ethical and compatible enterprise of modern man. To this end, in 1988, the MTA Board of Directors established a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of person or persons responsible for illegal trapping or snaring in Montana. Most recently the MTA Board reaffirmed this belief by increasing the reward to \$300.00 per incident.
